- **Academic Standing:** Candidates should possess strong legal research and drafting skills.

Roles & Responsibilities

- Assisting judicial and legal officers with case file reviews.
- Conducting extensive research on relevant statutory provisions and case laws.

- Observing court/tribunal proceedings and maintaining judicial records.
- Compiling a comprehensive research report/paper at the end of the internship.

1. **Curriculum Vitae (CV):** Highlighting academic achievements and research experience.
2. **Recommendation Letter:** Issued by the Dean or authorized faculty of the student's Law College/University, and addressed to the Registrar of the Karnataka Appellate Tribunal.
3. **Student Identity Card:** A valid ID proof issued by the educational institution.
