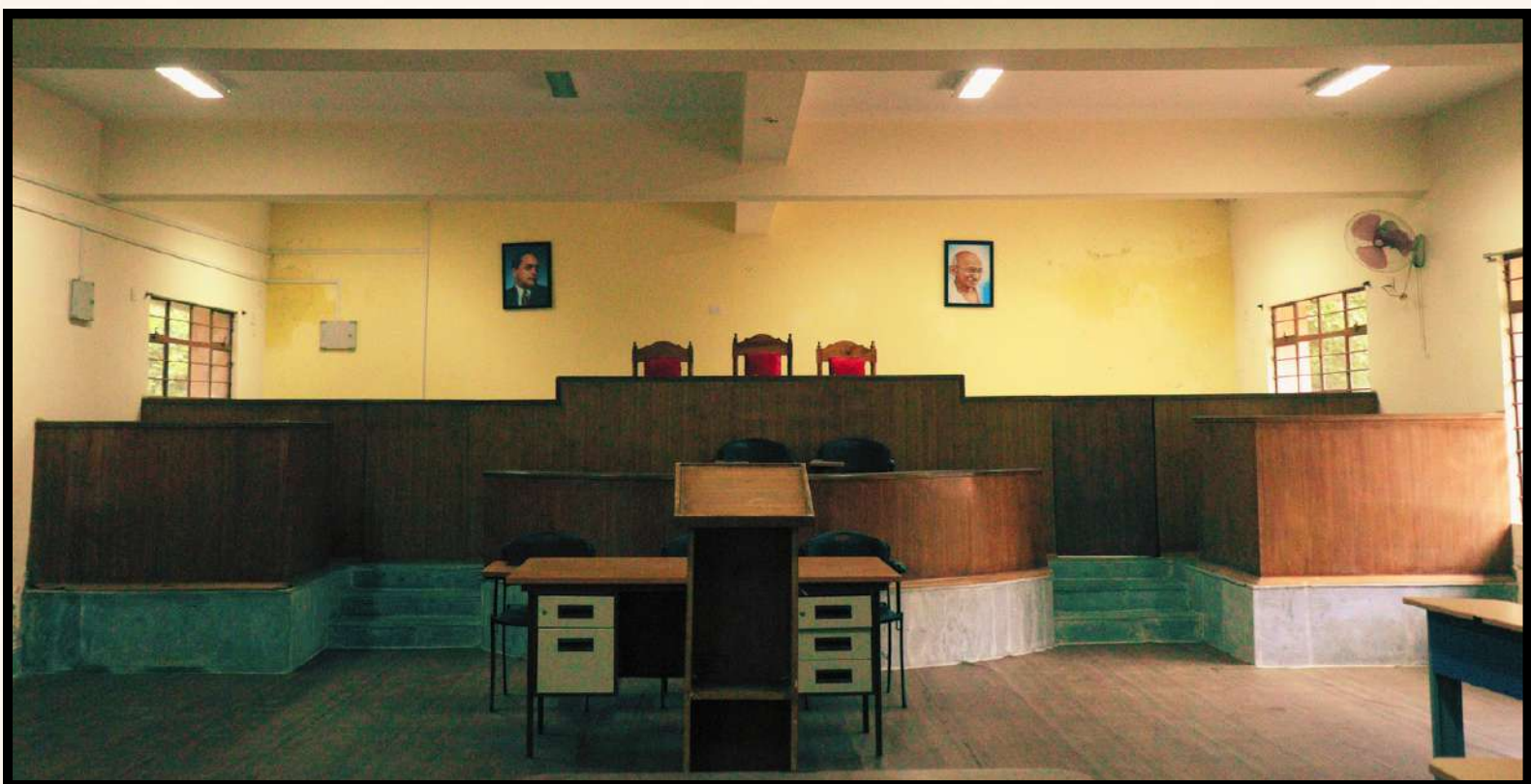
DEPARTMENT OF LAW

THE COMPETITION

The 3rd North-Eastern Hill University National Moot Court Competition, 2026, will mark its return after 8 years with a renewed objective to engage law students in a comprehensive discourse of contemporary legal issues. With previous editions laying the foundation for strong student advocacy, skill strengthening and coherent arguments on pertinent legal matters, this new edition aspires to connect law students across diverse regions through a shared, yet an enhanced passion, zeal and determination to shape the next generation of legal experts. With new avenues settling for polarising legal discussions and novel concepts of law intercepting the minds of legal professionals, this competition aims to provide a centre stage amidst our lush campus for widespread participation of young students. The success of the previous editions is a testament to this mandate and the current and future endeavours of the North-Eastern Hill University National Moot Court Competition will continue to transcend regional boundaries, intellectual rigour, and the spirit of advocacy.



PREVIOUS EDITIONS

The Department of Law, North-Eastern Hill University, has consistently strived to promote advocacy, legal research, and experiential learning through moot court competitions. In pursuit of this objective, the Department successfully organized the 1st North-Eastern Hill University National Moot Court Competition in October, 2016, laying the foundation for a tradition of academic excellence and competitive advocacy.

Building on the success of the inaugural edition, the 2nd North-Eastern Hill University National Moot Court Competition was organized in October, 2018. Both editions provided participants with a platform to develop and showcase their skills in legal research, memorial drafting, and oral advocacy. More importantly, these competitions brought together law students from diverse institutions across the country, fostering intellectual exchange, professional growth, and a spirit of excellence in legal education.

OVERVIEW OF COMPETITION

Date and Venue

- The Virtual Rounds shall be conducted via Google Meet on 29th and 30th September, 2026.
- The Physical Rounds shall be conducted on 29th and 30th October, 2026 at Department of Law, NEHU.

Eligibility Criteria

- The Competition is open to bona fide students duly enrolled in a regular Undergraduate Law Programme (Three-Year or Five-Year LL.B.) or a Postgraduate Law Programme (LL.M.) offered by an institution recognised by the Bar Council of India.
- Each recognised University, Law School, or College shall nominate only a single team to represent it in the Competition.

Team Composition

- The Competition shall accommodate a maximum of 36 teams from Universities and Law Colleges across the country.
- Each team shall consist of two or three members.
- In a team comprising three members, two members shall serve as Speakers and one member shall serve as the Researcher.
- In a team comprising two members, both participants shall serve as Speakers, and the Researcher Test may be undertaken by either member of the team.

Registration Process

- Registration for the Competition shall commence at 12:00 A.M. on 28th July, 2026, and shall remain open until 11:59 P.M. on 28th August, 2026.
- The Competition is limited to 36 teams, and registrations shall be accepted on a first-come, first-serve basis.
- Interested teams must complete the registration process through the registration link provided below:

- A registration fee of ₹1,500/- per team shall be payable at the time of registration. The registration fee, once paid, shall be non-refundable and non-transferable.
- Teams qualifying for the Physical Rounds shall be provided complimentary accommodation and meals for the duration of the Competition.
- Teams advancing to the Octa-Finals, Quarter-Finals, Semi-Finals, and Final Round shall be required to complete an additional physical registration and verification process upon arrival at the venue.

Competition Rounds

- The Competition shall comprise the following rounds:
 - Preliminary Round
 - Octa-Final Round
 - Quarter-Final Round
 - Semi-Final Round
 - Final Round

- The Preliminary Rounds shall be conducted in Virtual Mode on 29th–30th September, 2026, with participation from all registered teams.
- The Octa-Final, Quarter-Final, Semi-Final, and Final Rounds shall be conducted in Physical Mode at the Department of Law, North-Eastern Hill University, Shillong, on 29th–30th October, 2026.
- Of the 36 participating teams, the top 16 teams shall qualify for the Octa-Final Round. Subsequently, 8 teams shall advance to the Quarter-Final Round, 4 teams to the Semi-Final Round, and 2 teams shall compete in the Final Round.
- The Researchers' Test shall be conducted in Physical Mode on 29th October, 2026 for all teams qualifying for the Physical Round.

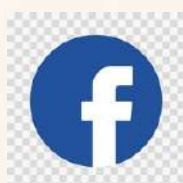
