To be considered for the Award, Applicants should submit their Papers of up to 10,000 words by **30 April 2027** to eucmlaward@gmail.com (please make sure the paper complies with the EuCML Submission Guidelines, available [here](#)).

All Papers tackling pressing issues in Consumer and Market Law will be considered, with a focus on **Fairness in Consumer and Market Law.**

Applications are welcome from scholars regardless of their length of experience.

In order to encourage the development of innovative ideas on Consumer and Market Law, the EuCML offers a platform for the presentation and discussion of the **best four submitted Papers**.

For this purpose, the EuCML Editors will – after double-blind peer review of the submitted Papers – select four Papers to be **presented and discussed at the in-person EuCML Annual Conference** to take place in fall 2027.

Each of the selected Papers will be assigned to **two Discussants**, leading Scholars in the field of Consumer and Market Law.

All **Keynote Speakers, Chairs and Discussants** will constitute the **Jury awarding the EuCML Award** to one of the Papers.

The Papers presented at the conference will be published in **Issue 6/2027 of EuCML** – with the winning Paper receiving a Special Mention.

In addition, the author of the **winning Paper will receive a voucher, worth 1000 EUR**, for books of the C.H. Beck/Hart/Nomos Series.

Papers not selected for the EuCML Annual Conference will, provided they successfully pass the double-blind peer review process, also be considered for publication in other issues of EuCML upon Authors' interest.
