ABOUT THE EVENT

The event will be conducted on a massive scale, which may witness vigorous and cut-throat competition among the students from different programs i.e., 5 years B.A.LL.B., 3 years LL.B. This year the event will be conducted in offline mode.

We are inviting law colleges from all over India that foster and promote the cherished principles of Contemporary Law, to stay updated on significant Contemporary challenges and current events happening in the country.

The object of organizing this quiz competition is to celebrate the spirit of Contemporary Legal Subject such as Constitution, Cyber Law, IPR, International Law, Environmental Law and human Rights to instill advocates of the coming generation to have a feeling of pride in their chosen profession and respect towards the Country.



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THEME OF THE EVENT

In an era of rapid technological, social, and economic transformation, the law must continuously evolve to address emerging challenges and safeguard contemporary values. Contemporary law reflects this evolution by responding to several issues making legal awareness more relevant.

The 8th Amity Quiz on Contemporary Law (AQCL) 2026 provides an exciting platform for participants to test their knowledge of recent legal developments, landmark judicial decisions, and contemporary legal issues. By promoting critical thinking, legal awareness, and informed dialogue, the competition aims to inspire future legal professionals and responsible citizens to engage meaningfully with the ever-evolving legal landscape.

GENERAL RULES

- Only one entry per participant is allowed.
- There is no limit on the number of students participating from a single institute.
- Participants may not be replaced once they have registered.
- Students must carry their College ID cards, or a letter of approval signed by the HOI of their respective institutions.
- The participants will not be allowed to use mobile or any other electronic gadgets/devices.
- The preliminary and semifinal rounds will consist of MCQs and True/False statements, while the final round will include audio-visual questions.
- Participants will be assigned a unique identification code for the competition. The allocation of identification codes shall be subject to the final decision of the Core Committee.
- The decision of the Core Committee will be final and will not be subject to any change.
- **Participants must adhere to the competition dress code:**

Female participants should wear business formal attire, Western formal attire, or Indian formal attire in black and white.

Male participants should wear business formal or Western formal attire in black and white.

- THE REGISTRATION FEE IS NON-REFUNDABLE.

WHO CAN PARTICIPATE?

- Students pursuing 3-year or 5-year law courses are eligible to participate.
- Any number of students can participate from their institution.

Note: This competition is not a team-based competition and thus each student must participate individually.

ROUNDS

PRELIMINARY/ELIMINATION ROUND

- Each participant will be given a question paper containing 50 MCQs.
- Time limit - 45 minutes.
- There will be no negative marking. Qualifying participants will be selected for the semi-final round.

{Note: A Cut-Off list will be made and 50% of the students will qualify for the 2nd round.}

SEMI-FINAL ROUND

- This round will be conducted in MCQ mode and will consist of 25 questions.
- There will be negative marking of 0.25 per question.
- Time limit - 30 minutes

FINAL ROUND

- Each participant will be asked 10 objective questions in an audio-visual format.
- The time allotted for each question shall be one minute.
- Tie-breaker rounds will be conducted in the event of a tie.

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AWARDS AND PRIZES

- **Winner:** Certificate and a cash prize of Rs. 9,999/-
- **First Runner-Up:** Certificate and a cash prize of Rs. 3,100/-
- **Second Runner-Up:** Certificate and a cash prize of Rs. 2,100/-
- **Two Consolation Prize Winners:** Certificate and a cash prize of Rs. 1,100/- each

(Note: "Please be advised that terms and conditions apply, including the deduction of an 18% tax.")

IMPORTANT DATES

- Registration starts from 1st August 2026 (00:00hrs.)
- The last date for registration is 28th August, 2026, (23:59 hrs.)
- The registration will be deemed completed only when the E-form along with the payment receipt has been mailed on the official email ID.
- **Date of competition:** 3rd September 2026.

CERTIFICATE FOR PARTICIPANTS

- Certificate of Participation will be issued to those students who will participate in the competition and attend the valedictory session.
- The winner, 1st Runner-Up, 2nd Runner- Up and 2 consolation prize awardees shall be provided with a certificate of merit.
- NO CERTIFICATE will be provided IN CASE OF ABSENTIA.
